- e. Friederike Hoch explains how to become a NETT member:
The new NETT member must:
 - want to promote internationalization and mobility activities with NETT members
 - sign an intention document to become a NETT member. Such document must be signed by the Dean and by the coordinator of the International Office.It was decided that all NETT members should sign such a document.

 - f. Partners management
Friederike Hoch mentions it is important to define who are the permanent NETT members.
For this:
 - e.1 the partners who have not attended the last 3 meetings will be contacted in order to define their position. Those who don't show interest to continue or don't answer will be deleted from the email distribution list. (But it's important to send the invitation to the general international email address when people have left their position).
 - e.2 In order to keep the familiar and productive atmosphere in NETT and to make it possible for institutions to host the annual meeting we want to keep the network small and diverse - with a maximum of 2-3 institutions per country and about 50 participants at the NETT meeting.
 - e.3 we should only invite new partners from countries not represented so far.

 - g. Suggestion to have a partner from Ukraine: members are invited to send proposals to Sabine and Friederike

- 8.a Attila promotes its KA2 Erasmus+ project inviting all partners of this NETT network to join as strategic partners. Such promotion could be sent out before the next meeting so that members can check their institution's interest beforehand.
